JANUARY 1983

 $\underline{\text{WGUI}}$: 1630, 11/19, 0709-0803, SINPO=25343. 60's mx djs Hugh Hughs and Gus Guts. Had energetic sound--would say, "Man Oh Man" a lot. Had a couple of callers, one from Toronto. (ANDREWS, NJ)

FEBRUARY 1983

WQUT: 1630, 1/1, 0440-0722 fade out, SINFO=42213. I called their loop # (212) 352-9906 at 0458 and rang in the new year with them. Huey Hughes told me he would send me a tape of the prgm. Played listeners requests. What a new year's eve! (WALKENDORF,MI) 1629.8v. 1/1, 0510-0900, SIO=353. Called Hugh Hughes (same#) who put my call over the air. Crystal Goblin afterwards wishing them a happy new year. Played oldies and newer rock. Took requests over the phone--must have some record library! Other DJs were a YL and Gus Guts. Some reverb used. Promised to QSL. (PROVANCE,OH) 1630, 1/1, 0530. Took mx requests and rvcd a call from WART who anneed their supposed location. G.Guts said my QSL would be in the mail soon. (MICHAEL,PA) 1629, 1/1, 0747-0905. Using loop (212) 352-9906 for calls and offering to QSL phone calls. (DECKER,NY) 1630, 1/1, no time. Heard New Year's Eve. (ANDREWS,NJ) 1630, 1/1, 0437-0821+, I talked to Hugh Hughes and they said they were using less than 100 watts. Caller from MI. said hi to all ACE members. (FORTNEY,PA) 1630, 1/1, 0507-0620, SINPD=34443. Party noise in background, very good prgm. (PINTO,NY)

NOVEMBER 1983

WHOT: 91.5 Mhz, 9/24/83. 0620-1054*, SIO=454. Rock mx by the Beatles, Yardbirds, and with phone calls to their loop # (212) 352-9906. Host of the show was Joe Nasium. No OSL info given. (SPREMO,NY)

DECEMBER 1983

WHOT: 91.5, 10/8, 0433-0905, SIO=454. Third anniversary program with party sound effects. Jim Nasium and Hank Hayes were the hosts with rock mx and tapes of old pirates they used to run including "WILD". Plenty of calls to (212) 352-9906, including one from me. These guys are crazy. (SPREMO,NY) 91.5, 10/22, 0552-1106*, SIO=555. Jim Nasium and Hank Hayes played plenty of oldies and on-air requests till \$/off. (SPREMO,NY) 91.5, 10/31, 0404-1016, SIO=454. Halloween special with requests via (212) 569-9979 until 0520 when they started using (212) 352-9906. Pirate Joe from KPRC called, and so did I. They said they were brdcsting from a cemetary. They had a sexual fantasy contest, but the only caller was an old lady that just wanted to talk about dogs. (SPREMO,NY)

WHOT: 91.5, 11/25, 0325-0606. Host Jim Nasium played mostly 50s and 60s mx. Phone call from Hank Hayes (the other regular host). Used loop # (212) 465-0070. Technical difficulties through the program. (SPREMO, NY)

FEBRUARY 1984

WHOT: 91.5, 0922-1024*, SID=454. Relay of a legal station (this seems to be the new fad here) until 0930, then rock mx. They were putting in new equipment tonight. (SPREMO,NY) 91.5, 12/17 +0530-0820, SID=454. 50s and 60s mx with calls via (212) 432-9979. Christmas was tonight's theme. (SPREMO,NY) 91.5, 12/24, *0630-1127, SID=454. Hosts Jim Hasium and Hank Hayes played Christmas mx and took calls. (SPREMO,NY)

JUNE 1984

<u>WHOT</u>: 91.5, 4/14, 0530-0923, SI0=454. Stn has two phone lines now. These guys are as popular here as any college stn. (SPREMO,NY) 91.5, 4/21, 0440-1255, SI0=454. "The Hank and Jim Show"—their own sitcom. (SPREMO,NY)

OCTOBER 1984

WHOT: 91.9, 8/27, *0401-0600, SIO=454. Gave wrong dates so show must have been a tape. Also gave freq as 91.5. Neat jingles. Host Jim Nasium with echo effects. (RENINGER,NY) 91.9, 8/29, 0400-0630, SIO=355. Jim Nasium, Hank Hayes and Fete Sake as DJs. Taped show of two days previous. Oldies and FCs. (FOLLOCK,NY)

APRIL 1986

WHOT: 1626, 2/16, 0600-0630, SIO=383. Annot freq as 1620 and a half. Annot FM freq of 91.5. Brooklyn phone #. (PYM,DC via ACE BBS) 1626, 2/17, 0530-0700, SIO 228-444. Second night in a row. Had a few singing jingles and excellent audio quality. Clear sounding telephone calls. Only criticism was the unstable VFO. A fun stn! (PYM,DC via ACE BBS) 1630, 3/1, 0430+. Weak and drifty signal. Pro sounding. (MCLELLAN,MI via ACE BBS) 1630 3/8 0415+. Better signal than last time. Pop/rock mx w/slick annors taking phone calls (McCLELLAN, MI via ACE BBS) 1630, 3/8, 0450+. Very poor reception due to beacon. QRM. I did enjoy the slick style. My call raised their states-heard total 16! (LEVINE, KY via ACE BBS) 1630.4, 3/8, 0446-0500+, SIO=222. Oldies mx w/requests and phone calls to a (718) area code number. I talked to operator at this #. Annors were Jim Nazium, Pete Sake & Hank Hayes. Bad QRM. Very good audio. (WALKENDORF,MI) 1630, 3/22, 0404-0430. Playing old pop mx and taking phone calls. Promised QSL cards to callers. (O'BRIEN, NY via ACE BBS) 1629.4, 3/23, 0531-0624+, Having lots of fun, silly singing, talk, mentioned Brooklyn location ('Wonderful Radio Brooklyn') & gave out phone number, took several calls, including mine, said they were the same operators as WGUT. (PROVANCE,OH)

MAY 1986

WHOT: 1630v, 3/23, 0335-0630+, SIO=222. First heard tuning up with mx by The Carpenters on 1622 or 23. Then slid up to 1630. I called phone # from last month, and talked to the operators. All '60s and '70s mx with pro (and hyper) annoing Jim Nazium, Hank Hayes, and Pete Sayek. (WALKENDORF, MI) 1630, 3/23, 0404-0430. Playing old pop mx and taking phone calls. Promised QSL to callers. Tnx to Walkendorf for tip via DX Newsline. Also logged by Levine in KY. (OBRIEN, NY via ACE BBS) 1630.5, 3/29, 0356-0500+, SIO=222. Oldies mx. Taking calls to a Brooklyn #. Noticed slight reverb on annoments. Good signal. (WALKENDORF, MI) 1630, 4/12, 0500+. Left the air early due to tech difficulties. On at the same time on 91.9 FM was WFUN, in stereo!! (GARRITY, NY via ACE BBS)

JUNE 1986


WHOT: 1630, 4/12, 0501-0525, SIO=111. Oldies mx, much QRN and QRM. (WALKENDORF, MI) 1628.7, 5/25, 0600-0900+, SIO=222. Usual format with telephone requests and Top-40 style announcing. It was fun as usual to hear these guys doing their thing. (GARRITY, NY) 1628.6, 5/25, 0308. (DECKER, NY via OBRIEN and DX Newsline)

JULY 1986

WHOT: 1628, 5/25, 0250-0355, SIO=323-. Easy to copy signal on peaks, but would fade out here for 5 minutes or more at a time. Crazy music format, ranging from "Ballroom Blitz" and "We Will Rock You" to "Jingle Bell Rock" and Elvis mx. Equally crazy jokes about batteries. Mentioned numerous Memorial weekend bosts, but only hrd this one. (SMITH,NY) 1630, 5/26, 0301-0414, SIO=211. Jim Nasium & Hank Hayes w/ oldies like "Louie, Louie" & "Sixteen Candles." Phone # given w/212 area code. Called the number and got a recording that there was trouble on the line. (YODER,PA) 1620.4, 6/15, 0126-0259*, SIO=111. Stn played oldies and gave a Brooklyn phone # for QSL cards, which I never succeeded in reaching. I called the number on 6/17, and got Jim Nasium, the announcer, who claimed WHOT was not on the air on 6/15, but some unknown stn was rebosting WHOT. Jim indicated that WHOT stays primarily on FM for Brooklyn. (BUCHANAN,MA)

SEPTEMBER 1986 - ON THE COVER!

WHOT: 1627, 8/30, 0430. Good signals. Jim Nasium with usual oldies and jingles, annoing usual phone number and said they were running in on 91.5 mHz. (MARTIN, DE via ACE BBS) 1628, 8/30, 0540-0610. Had phone-in pgm. (NELSON, VA via ACE BBS) 1629, 9/1, 0009. Doors mx, jingles and annoing Brooklyn QTH. Fair signals. (MARTIN, DE via ACE BBS)



OCTOBER 1986

WHOT: 1629.5, 9/1, 0208-0400+, SIO=333. Took telephone calls at (718) 946-9748 and offered to QSL to Ontario caller and to play request. (DECKER, NY) 1626, 9/1, 0743-0818, SIO=212. Two anners W/talk and mx. Very hard to hear, but gave telephone number. Placed a call to them; they seemed like very friendly folks. They took my name and addr W/promise of QSL. Said they had lots of old Elvis mx. Even though the signal was poor, I'm glad to have heard them. During the phone call, they said they were NOT the "not the top 40" program on 1616-1618, although they were NOT the "not the top 40" program on 1627, 9/1, 0545-0630+, SIO=141. Dis with very hyper voices taking phone calls for QSL requests or to verify reception. Said they also have an FM xmtr. Too bad they don't have an SW outlet; very entertaining. (NOSIK, IL) 1628, 9/1, 0351-0132. Oldies from 50's and 60's W/DJ Jim Nasjum. Called and they played request 5 minutes Inter. Lots of Jingles and IDs. Said they would QSL. (ROSS, ONT)

NOVEMBER 1986

WHOT: 1628, 7/5, 0228-0740, SIO=242. Liberty weekend show. Jim Nasium and Pete Sayk up to their usual frantic antics, including going out on the roof to shoot off bottle rockets and Jim broadcasting from the shower. They took a bunch of on-air calls from a 718 number (946-9748). Mx was the normal oldies mix. Several TV themes were tossed in including "The Jetsons", "Green "Acres", and "Casper The Friendly Ghost". I counted six different pro-sounding jingles used this xmsn. They told one caller they'd been on since 4:30 local time, still on with QSB sneaking in when I left for work at 0740. Great fun as always. (SMITH.MY) 1630, 7/6, 0319-0444+, SIO=111. Usual slick pgm of 60's mx and phone calls. Called at 0400 and talked to Pete Sake. Promised a QSL in 3 weeks. Tax to Velko for s. (YODER, PA)

JANUARY 1987

WHOT: 1629.6, 1/1, 0315-0736. SIO=323. New Year's Eve live program with celebrations for each time zone. Lots of 'countdowns' to midnight, plus rock & roll mx. Took calls from listeners at (718) number. Annor answered my call, he was very friendly and promised to QSL though he noted they were short of funds. On the air, they annot 1620 ½ frequency. (RICHOLSON,VA) 1628.8, 1/1, 0717-0737+. SIO=222-111. Taking phone calls, seemed like a simulcast of an FM boast. Faded out by 0737. (PROVANCE,OH) 1629, 1/1, 0555-0825+. New Year's show with Pete Sake, Jim Nasium & Hank Hayes. Rock oldies and call-ins with callers from Canada. (PYM,DC) 1630, 1/23, 0430-0500+. SIO=233. Heard during the great East Coast snow-in! Live phone calls and rock oldies. (PYM,DC)
